

MAI® Water Soluble Oil Fine Art Class Supply list:

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Disposable oil palate

Yogurt lids (4-5)

Paint rags and/or Paper towels

Water container for cleaning brushes – Clean plastic milk jug will work

Metal palette knife (triangle/diamond pointed type)

Painting smock or expendable clothing (old T-shirts long to cover slacks/jeans)

Water Soluble Oil paint see below

Water Soluble Oil: (Windsor & Newton or Holbein-Duo Aqua)

Water soluble Linseed oil medium (small sq. bottle)

1. Prussian blue
2. Red hue/Rose (warm red)
3. Cad Yellow hue/Light yellow
4. Burnt Siena
5. Titanium white

Suggested Brushes: (if you have brushes bring them and they will be reviewed)

Number 4 Fan brush

Number 4 Brilliant

Number 2 Fat

Number 4 Round

Number 10 Flat

Number 2 Round

2 Canvas (medium size)

One 12x24 canvas (museum canvas) type

One 20x24 canvas (museum canvas) type

NOTE: Museum canvas type is a thicker canvas. No visible staples along the sides. We will be painting the sides. Museum canvas will not require framing.

5 photo picture reference material. We will be painting from picture references. Picture material should have shadows, strong shapes and figures. Try to keep picture references simple and full of color and shapes. Please bring up to 5 picture references to make a selection to paint from. Best reference material is from your own photographs.

A small bag/back pack is suggested to contain the art supplies. Please mark the bag and supplies with student name.
